Statement Concerning Availability of Additional Information
On Actual Broadcast Dates, Times, Classification, Quantity and Costs
Of Political Advertising

The political advertising contracts contained in our political broadcast file reflect the various classifications, length and quantity of advertising purchased, the scheduled dates and times of broadcast and projected rates. However, because of traffic procedures, preemption, technical difficulties, subsequent schedule changes or for other reasons, the classification, length and quantity of the advertising actually broadcast and the actual rate that was paid by the advertiser may be different from that reflected in the contracts.

If any member of the public wishes to obtain the actual classification, length and quantity of advertising, the actual date and time of broadcast and the actual of charges paid for any political advertising broadcast on the station (including the per unit cost), please review the political advertising invoices, or if you need assistance, please contact the station staff person who has custody of our political broadcasting file, or ask to speak with the Sales Manager or General Manager of the station. We will be pleased to provide this information to you along with the date, amount and other information concerning any make-goods or rebates that may have been issued.

It is our desire to timely furnish members of the public with all information required by federal law concerning the actual classification, length, quantity, date and time of broadcast, as well as charges made for all political advertising broadcast on our stations. We are pleased to assist you in this regard, and we will furnish this information to you immediately, upon request, from our program logs and billing records if it is not reflected on the contracts in the political file.
